Re: Shore Street Remedial Works, Port of Inverness

MARINE (SCOTLAND ACT) 2010, PART 4 MARINE LICENCING, MARINE LICENCE APPLICATION FOR CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS

I write to you regarding the request for a Marine Licence for Construction Projects on behalf of the Port of Inverness for their proposed remedial works to the quayside on Shore Street.

The following documents have been provided in support of the application. These include:

- Completed Marine Licence for Construction Projects application form;
- Port of Inverness Shore Street Quay Remedial Works Environmental Report including:
 - Schedule of Mitigation (as Appendix 1);
 - Drawings (as Appendix 2) including; 50/01 Site Location, 59/02 Noise and dust Receptors, 59/03 Cultural Heritage Sites, 59/04 Designated Sites, 59/05 Waterbody Classification;
 - Noise Monitoring Data (as Appendix 3);
 - HRA Pre-Screening Report (as Appendix 4);
 - Ornithological Survey Report (as Appendix 5);
 - Otter Survey Report (as Appendix 6); and
 - Flood Risk Assessment (as Appendix 7).
- Pre-Application Consultation Report for Proposed Remedial Works to Shore Street Quay.

It should be noted that within 'Section 2: Project Description' of the Environmental Report, it is stated that the flood wall will be realigned, and associate drainage installed as part of the project. The implications of the flood wall realignment are discussed within the report, as if it were, to go ahead the works may be carried out at the same time. It is important to highlight that the realignment of the flood wall, and drainage installation is yet to be confirmed. The flood wall and drainage elements fall under the definition of building works over landforms and thus, would be consented via a planning application to the Highland Council and hence are not a part of the Marine Licence Application for Construction.

I would be grateful if you would acknowledge the receipt of this application, and the associated documents.
